This concert explores the ever-changing repertoire for string quartet. The evocative 1772 quartet by J. Haydn is followed by Italian D. P. Runcini's 2017 composition exploring four ancestral dances. The daring 2022 composition by American S. Farhat is coupled with a ground-breaking composition by Brazilian H. Villa-Lobos first written in 1915 and extensively revised in 1946.
