Dramatic soprano Heidi Muendel MMus has recently returned to Canada after 10 years singing and teaching in Europe. Some of Heidi's operatic credits include: *the title roles of Turandot, Ariadne auf Naxos and Norma*, Leonora from *Fidelio*, Amelia in *Un Ballo in Maschera*, and Santuzza from *Cavalleria rusticana*. Her concert credits include: Verdi's *Requiem*, Beethoven's *9th Symphony* and solo concerts with the Vancouver, Victoria, and Winnipeg Symphony orchestras. Heidi is stepping back on to the performance stage after a short pause and continues to teach both her European and Canadian students, conduct two local choirs, and offer vocal workshops internationally.

In his spare time, Gray runs his own jewelry business with his mum (Gray's Crafts), and he enjoys playing soccer, basketball and volleyball for his school teams.
